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SPAS Good News

- SPAS had their Middle States Re-accreditation visit the last week of March and was recommended for re-accreditation!
- Through \$275,000 in grants received in the last year, SPAS has:
 - Painted the hallways, stairwell, cafeteria, and most classrooms!
 - installed 4 AEDs.
 - renovated the 4th floor to create a Middle School complete with lockers and subjectspecific teachers.
 - begun the process of hiring a development director for the 23-24 school year.
 - received funding for safety and security improvements including: cameras, security lighting, security signage, trauma kits, and gokits.

New Student Registration

SPAS is registering new students in all grades for the 2023-2024 school year!

- New families in Kindergarten receive a Welcome Grant of \$1,000.
- New families in Grades 2-7 receive a Transfer Grant of \$1,000.
- Spanish speaking families are eligible for an additional grant provided by an outside agency.
- 75% of our school families receive tuition assistance from various other groups.

EITC

Keeping Catholic education affordable is one of our top priorities and the EITC program is essential for providing tuition assistance for our families.

How does EITC work?

Individuals or businesses that have a PA tax liability are eligible to redirect their tax dollars to St. Peter the Apostle School and receive a 90% tax credit. These funds are used for tuition assistance for our students and enable many families to attend our school!
