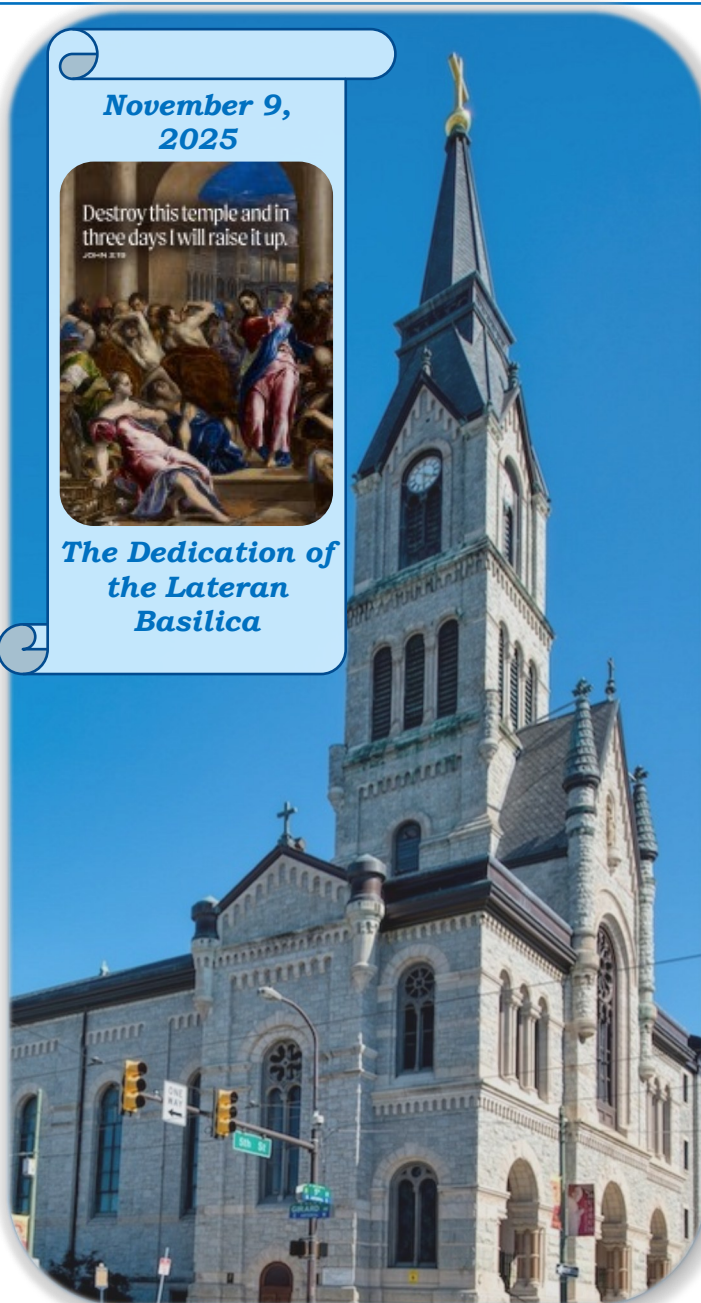

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: The Sacrament of Baptism is administered monthly. Arrangements are made in advance at the Rectory. Sponsors must provide proof of eligibility by a letter from their respective pastors, and must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation. Parents attend a Pre-Jordan meeting prior to Baptism, which is arranged at a mutually convenient time.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made with the pastor at least six months before the date of the wedding. Pre-Cana instructions are required. Couples rather than parents or wedding coordinators should contact the church. If either party was previously married, an annulment must be granted prior to the selection of a future wedding date.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

Catholic Charities in Philadelphia is facing a critical challenge. Due to the ongoing federal government shutdown, funding for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits has been suspended, leaving thousands of families and seniors in our community without access to essential food assistance. This suspension means:

- No SNAP benefits for low-income households.
- No federal safety net for families struggling to put food on the table.

We are already witnessing the impact of this situation. Visits to food pantries, which provide cold-weather essentials to Philadelphians experiencing homelessness and poverty, doubled. Additionally, food pantries have seen a significant increase in demand over the past few weeks, and this trend may continue in the coming weeks.

To address this urgent need, Catholic Charities in Philadelphia must purchase twice as much food for their pantries to ensure that no one is sent away hungry. We now turn to our community. This is a moment that calls for compassion, courage, and community action. As Catholics, we are guided by the Gospel to care for the poor, feed the hungry, and protect the dignity of every person.

Can you help us answer this call? Here at St. Peter's, we are looking to begin addressing this need deliberately and intentionally by providing turkeys, food bags, and baskets to those in need. If you are interested in donating turkeys, canned goods, or perishables, please call the parish office at 215-627-2386 or stop by with your donation.

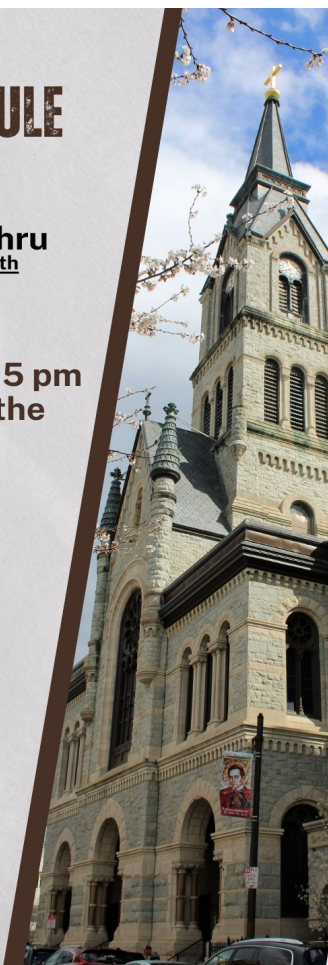

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

Queridos Feligreses,

Las organizaciones benéficas católicas en Filadelfia se enfrentan a un desafío crítico. Debido al cierre en curso del gobierno federal, se ha suspendido la financiación de los beneficios del Programa de Asistencia Nutricional Suplementaria (SNAP), dejando a miles de familias y personas mayores en nuestra comunidad sin acceso a asistencia alimentaria esencial. Esta suspensión significa:

- No hay beneficios SNAP para hogares de bajos ingresos.

- No hay red de seguridad federal para las familias que luchan por poner comida en la mesa.

Ya estamos presenciando el impacto de esta situación. Las visitas a despensas de alimentos, que proporcionan elementos esenciales para el clima frío a los habitantes de Filadelfia que experimentan la falta de vivienda y la pobreza, se duplicaron. Además, las despensas de alimentos han visto un aumento significativo en la demanda en las últimas semanas, y esta tendencia puede continuar en las próximas semanas.

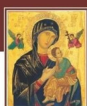
Para abordar esta necesidad urgente, las organizaciones benéficas católicas en Filadelfia deben comprar el doble de comida para sus despensas para garantizar que nadie sea enviado con hambre. Ahora nos remos a nuestra comunidad. Este es un momento que requiere compasión, coraje y acción comunitaria. Como católicos, estamos guiados por el Evangelio para cuidar a los pobres, alimentar a los hambrientos y proteger la dignidad de cada persona.

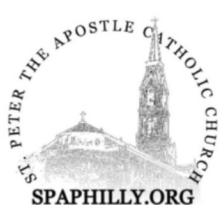

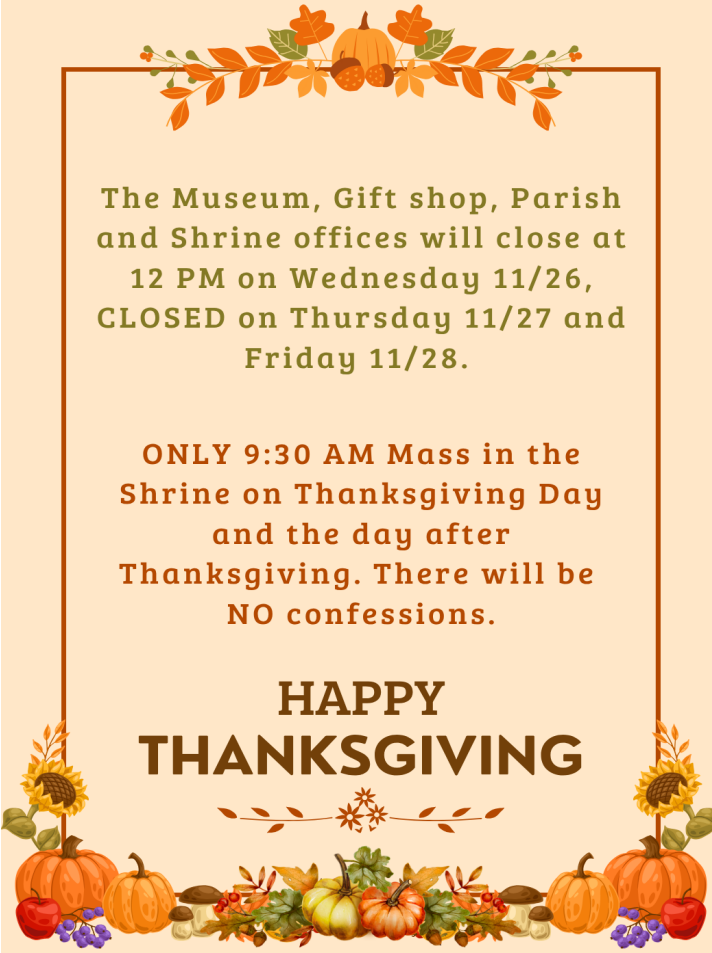

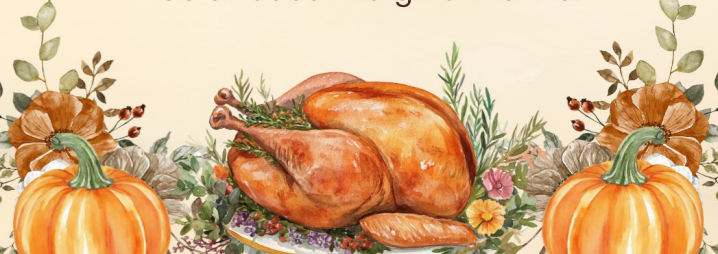
