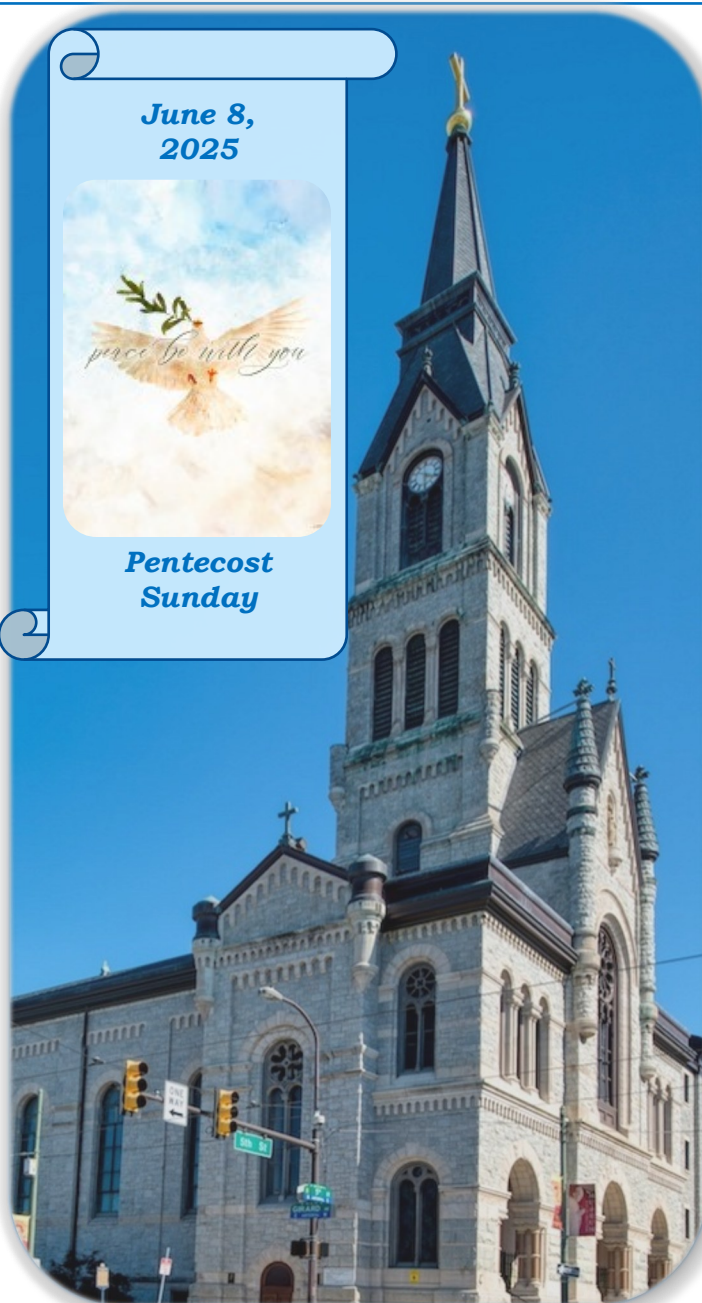

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: The Sacrament of Baptism is administered monthly. Arrangements are made in advance at the Rectory. Sponsors must provide proof of eligibility by a letter from their respective pastors, and must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation. Parents attend a Pre-Jordan meeting prior to Baptism, which is arranged at a mutually convenient time.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made with the pastor at least six months before the date of the wedding. Pre-Cana instructions are required. Couples rather than parents or wedding coordinators should contact the church. If either party was previously married, an annulment must be granted prior to the selection of a future wedding date.

Dear Parishioners,



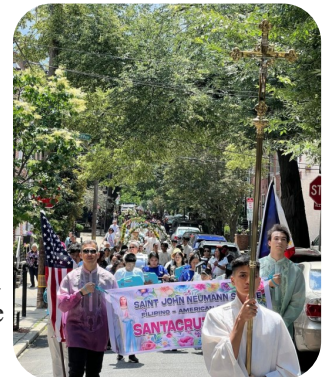
This past Saturday, May 31st, our Filipino American community celebrated the 48th annual Santacruzán/Flores de Mayo. This special event is always a highlight in the Filipino calendar, bringing together towns and cities across the country in a joyous celebration.

Santacruzán is a beautiful and meaningful occasion, rich in history and tradition. Originating in the 1800s, it's now a key part of the Flores de Mayo (Flowers of May) festivities. This event honors Queen Helena of Constantinople, the mother of Constantine the Great, who famously led a pilgrimage to find the cross on which Jesus was crucified. Along with her, we celebrate the virtues of hope, charity, and faith. The entire month of May is dedicated to honoring the Virgin Mary, and during this time, we offer special prayers and beautiful flowers.

Santacruzán takes place at the end of Flores de Mayo, typically on the third Saturday of May, and it feels like the perfect way to wrap up the festivities before the rainy season begins in the Philippines in June.

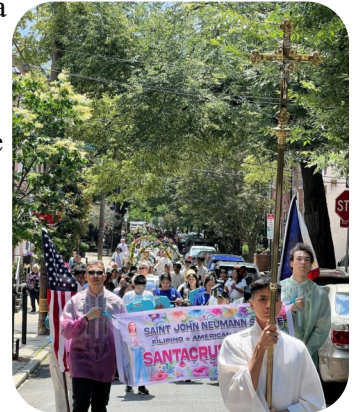
Queridos Feligreses,

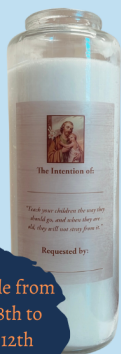
